

The Nagamori Foundation is proud to announce the 7th Nagamori Awards

Awards:

Grand Nagamori Award - 5 million yen, Nagamori Award - 2 million yen.

Commendation:

The Nagamori Awards will be given to approximately six people.

The winner of the Grand Nagamori Award will be announced at the commendation ceremony.

Application period:

November 01, 2020 - January 31, 2021

Areas covered:

Technical fields related to motors, actuators and power generators, and their control methods, application technologies, etc.

Requirements for application:

Applicants must be entry to mid-career researchers or development engineers who have made an outstanding achievement in the fields covered by the Nagamori Awards.

Entry to mid-career – normally defined as no more than 30 years of research after obtaining the Bachelor's degree.

Conditions to win Nagamori Awards:

Candidates must attend the Awards ceremony to be held on September 05, 2021, give a lecture in English, and submit all the documents requested by the Secretariat (Nagamori Foundation will bear travelling expenses and accommodation fees for the winner and his/her companion to attend the Awards ceremony).

Candidates, regardless of their nationality, domiciles, etc., must be able to communicate in either English or Japanese.

Nomination

Self-nomination and/or nomination from academic institution are accepted.

A recommendation letter by an expert in the field covered by the Awards, or a senior member of your Academic Society, organization, research department, etc. must be submitted.

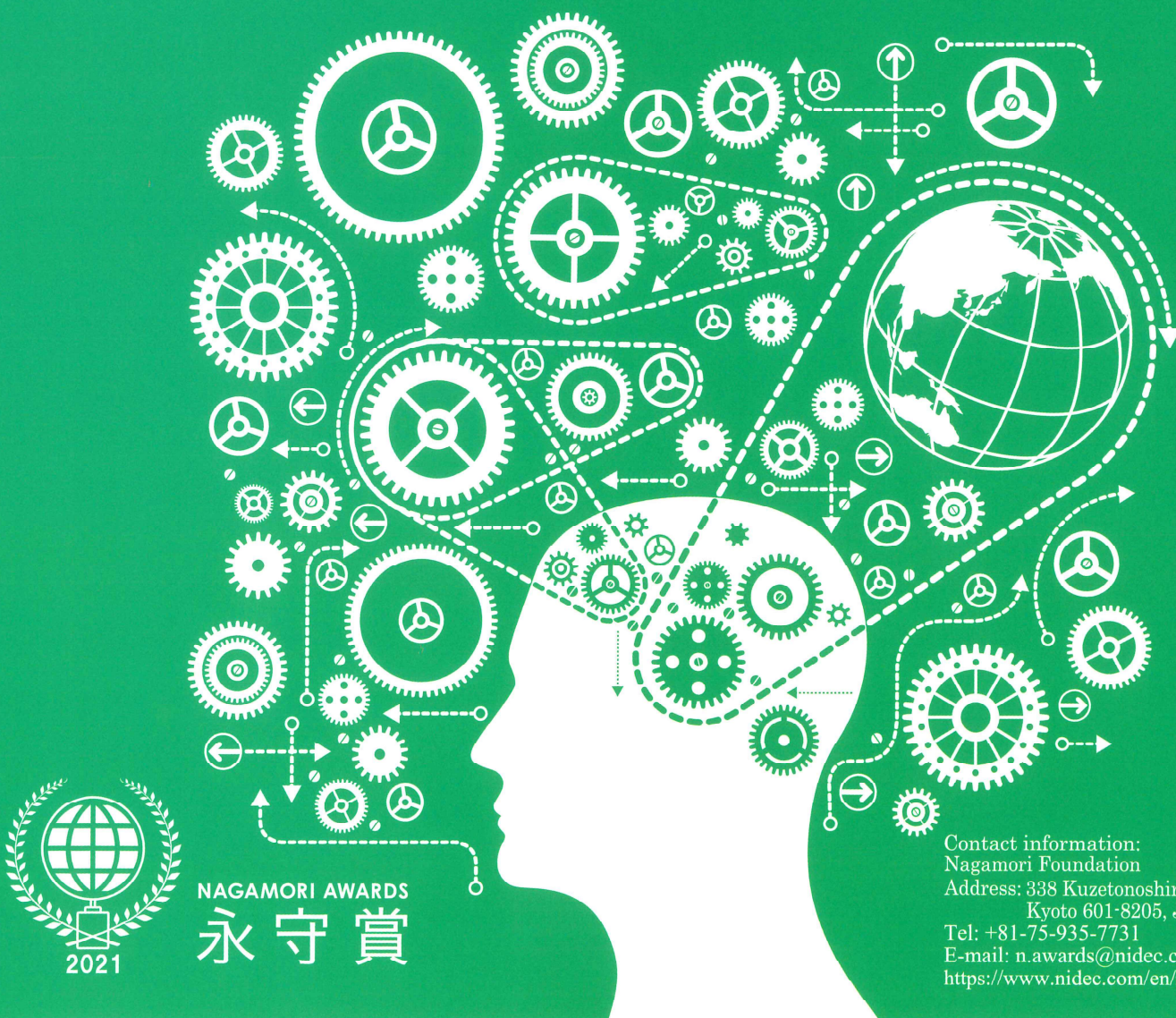
Announcement of the winners:
